WEAC and CAUS Roll Out Recall Plans

Here's a math quiz. If each one of Wisconsin's nearly 100,000 WEAC members finds 10 people to sign a recall petition, how many signatures will we have? If you said one million, you would go to the head of the class. Since we only need a little more than a half million to effect a recall, that could happen - if we all do our part.

In fact, this is part of the union's "4 by 10" plan to unseat Governor Walker. The other tens refer to a commitment from each member for 10 hours of campaigning, a \$10 donation, and getting 10 people to go and cast a vote.

But it all starts with those recall petitions, so that's what you need to know today. There are some do's and don'ts in collecting signatures, and you can find out what they are by attending a training session.
