Cedar Lake United Educators Scholarship Application

The CLUE Scholarship is established to provide financial assistance to children of CLUE members who are seeking to pursue a degree from a university or technical college. Those chosen to receive the scholarship will be granted \$1000 to be used to pay for part of the recipient's fees and tuition, provided they meet the first semester requirements.

To be eligible for a CLUE Scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be a child of a member of CLUE. The applicant may also be the child of a person who died while holding a membership in CLUE.
2. Present a completed application consisting of:
 - a) This application form;
 - b) A current official high school transcript including seventh semester grades;
 - c) An essay, not to exceed 300 words, stating what the applicant perceived to be his/her civic duty and how he/she plans to fulfill this duty in the future;
 - d) A statement signed by the applicant's guidance counselor or by administrative personnel certifying the applicant's cumulative grade point average on a four-point scale and certifying class rank; and
 - e) Two (2) letters of recommendation;
 1. One (1) letter must be from a classroom teacher who is familiar with the applicant's academic performance and school activities; and
 2. One (1) letter must be from a community member, outside the school setting, who is familiar with the applicant's involvement in community activities.
3. Be a high school senior.
4. Planning to pursue a degree at a university or technical college.
5. The applicant must rank in the top 25% of his/her graduating class or have achieved a 3.0 cumulative grade point average (based on a non-weighted 4.0 scale) at the time of application.
6. Show evidence of involvement in school and community activities.

PLEASE NOTE:

1. Applications must be submitted on the approved CLUE application form. Incomplete applications or applications forwarded to the CLUE Scholarship Committee postmarked later than February 15 will not be considered.
2. Answer all questions and complete all blanks in ink.
3. Use N/A (not applicable) where questions do not apply.
