**Re:** Election of Retired Members as Delegates to the NEA Representative Assemblies

WEAC is eligible for eleven retired delegates to the NEA Representative Assembly. We are holding an election among WEAC-Retired/NEA-R members to select delegates for a two-year term (2012-2013). The 2012 NEA Convention will be held June 30-July 5 in Washington, D.C. The 2013 NEA Convention will be held July 1-6 in Atlanta, Georgia. The elected retired delegates to the NEA RA are also the voting delegates to the NEA-Retired Annual meeting that is held immediately prior to and at the same site as the NEA RA.

All WEAC-Retired/NEA-R members are eligible to run for a state delegate position, nominate other WEAC-Retired/NEA-R members as candidates and to vote in the delegate election.

Nominations are to be submitted, in writing, to the office of the WEAC Executive Director, P. O. Box 8003, Madison, Wisconsin, 53708, postmarked no later than February 1 or electronically to the Executive Director no later than midnight February 1, 2012. If the nominee is not submitting his/her own candidacy, the nomination must be accompanied by a signed statement from the nominee indicating his/her willingness to run for and to fulfill the requirements of office. After the nomination deadline, a ballot will be sent to each WEAC-Retired NEA-R member. Each ballot must be returned in a sealed envelope to the WEAC postmarked no later than **APRIL 1, 2012.**

The eleven candidates receiving the highest number of votes in the election which determines the retired delegates shall be declared elected retired NEA state delegates. The candidate receiving the twelfth, etc., highest number of votes in the election shall be declared elected alternate retired NEA state delegates, respectively.

**The elected retired delegates will receive a stipend from the WEAC to cover expenses as approved by the WEAC Board of Directors. *The payment of the stipend is contingent upon the delegates' attendance at the NEA-R Annual meetings.***

We encourage and look forward to your participation in this election.
