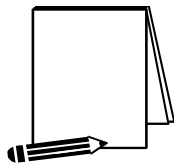

We are the Instructional and Professional Development (IPD) Committee, a part of the Winnebagoland UniServ. The IPD committee wants to be the source of information for the membership of Winnebagoland for PI-34. The committee believes that the membership should and must know about the renewal of their professional teaching license through the rules covered under the regulatory code known as PI-34. We



are trained professionals here to assist you in writing, preparing and approving your

Professional Development Plan (PDP). The Committee has developed a 6-part training and verification series in support of initial and professional educators. Our services are **free**, courtesy of your association membership dues.

Did you know...

That WEAC, along with other partners, has developed a flexible online tool that will help you organize your PDP, complete the necessary paperwork, and even assist you in finding team members?

The Quality Educator Interactive (QEI) is a free online resource for WEAC members. It contains the DPI-approved PDP templates as well as related DPI directions and review checklists for each PDP section. You will find it at <http://qei.wisconsin.edu/>

Did you know...

That some agencies and team members will charge you a fee for approval or verification of your plan?

Don't let that happen! You do not need to pay anyone to approve your plan. The Winnebagoland UniServ IPD Committee is here to help you through the PDP process at no cost, including identifying team members who will approve your PDP for free.

PDP Timeline

- Year 1:** self-reflection, work with a Mentor, goal selection, plan formulation
- Year 2:** plan writing, goal revisions, goal approval, artifacts
- Year 3-5:** complete annual review, document plan, submit DPI paperwork, plan approval
