Your rights are under attack

Governor Scott Walker is proposing to wipe away decades of collective bargaining for teachers, support staff and other public workers in Wisconsin. The right to organize, the right to bargain health insurance or prep time, the right to have a voice in the profession – all of those things and more are under attack in Walker’s budget bill This is an strike on public workers, unions and the dedicated professionals in classrooms across the state. This is an attack on worker rights.

It is up to us to take a stand and say NO to shortsighted fixes that attack public workers. It is up to us to organize and show lawmakers that the state budget should not be balanced on the backs of teachers, support staff and other professionals in our classrooms.

Here’s the threat: Your rights will be taken away. Your ability to organize will be eliminated. Your take-home pay will be slashed. Your entire job will change – and you will have no say in what happens.

Take Action Now to keep your professional rights:

- **Visit www.weac.org/cyberlobby.** Tell your state legislators to vote NO to shortsighted budget fixes. Tell them the state budget shouldn’t be balanced on the backs of dedicated public workers.

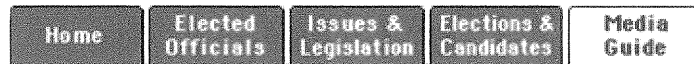


Letters to the editor & social media
