Act 10 has changed the landscape for public sector unions in Wisconsin and upcoming timelines for non-renewal, layoff, and individual contracts for 2012-13 bring several questions into focus:

- How does Act 10, together with your contract extension, impact current state law for non-renewals?
- With or without a contract extension -- does Act 10 change the non-renewal process under Wisconsin §118.22?
- February 29, 2012 is the non-renewal deadline under Wisconsin §118.22 -- will that date also mark deadlines for layoffs in your district?
- Will Act 10 affect the types of exit/resignation agreements Districts can offer to non-renewed teachers?
- Without a collective bargaining agreement, how will members' rights concerning layoff and non-renewal be protected?
- Individual contracts, by law, are to be issued by March 15, 2012 -- is this process different under Act 10?
- What should and should not be included in individual contracts?
