

## CWUC TECHNICAL COLLEGE STANDING COMMITTEE

The CWUC Technical College Standing Committee met on December 10, 2009, at the CWUC Office. After reviewing the objectives, responsibilities, and budget considerations for the committee, the group decided to offer scholarships to pay the registration fee for three members of CWUC technical college locals who wish to attend the WEAC Winter Conference to be held March 6 in Wausau. This committee will also encourage others to attend the Winter Conference.

State legislative code requires colleges to have local faculty certification committees; however, many of these committees have become relatively inactive. WEAC will be informing local union presidents of the duties of the certification committees. Issues affecting counselors/advisors will be discussed at an Academic Leadership Council meeting on February 6 in Stevens Point. The CWUC Technical College Committee will encourage counselor/advisors and interested faculty and staff to attend this meeting.

A WEAC/AFT coordinated bargaining meeting will be held on January 30 in Stevens Point. The CWUC Technical College Committee will encourage at least one person from each technical college local to attend this meeting to network with others and find out more information on bargaining together.

Unit clarification and job description revision were also brought up as topics to be discussed.
