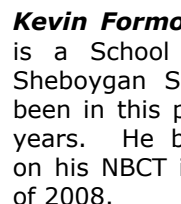

## 12 KMUC Members earn National Board Certification



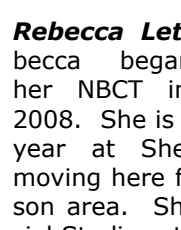

**Kevin Formolo, SEA** Kevin is a School Counselor at Sheboygan South and has been in this position for six years. He began working on his NBCT in September of 2008.



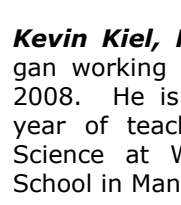
